





















The Performance Program

Every year, over 100 Miami-Dade County youth are selected to participate in our performance program. Anyone age 8-22 can audition to join! Students come from all across our county; over 50 schools are represented in our program each season.

Choral ensembles rehearse weekly from September to May, in preparation for performances throughout the season. In the program students learn the necessary skills to be practicing and professional musicians, along with discipline, commitment, and the rewards of sustained and dedicated effort.

Throughout its long history, MCC has prepared young people to appear and record with artists in a wide variety of musical settings. We have sung with the Cleveland Orchestra, the Israel Chamber Orchestra, Queen Latifah at the 44th NFL Super Bowl, André Rieu and Ethan Bortnick for PBS, Barry Manilow, Gloria Estefan, Manuel Turizo, Paquito D'Riera, Jon Secada, and Raul Di Blasio. In addition to national and international tours, MCC has performed numerous productions with the Florida Grand Opera, former Florida Philharmonic Orchestra, Master Chorale of South Florida, Miami Bach Society, Festival Miami and the Mainly Mozart Festival.



Community Programs

From free sing-along concerts, to after-school chorus programs, to songwriting workshops for youth, MCC has offered free, family friendly community programs and events since the 1990's! Ultimately, these programs increase access for all children to participate in choral singing.

This season, MCC will launch its BIG SING project in partnership with the Adrienne Arsht Center. The Big Sing project brings together four local choral organizations (two children's choirs and two adult choirs) to lead a county-wide initiative that will bring people of all ages together to sing again. The project includes free workshops at partnering schools/groups, free pop-up community sing-alongs, and digital resources in preparation for a culminating community sing-along in the Knight Concert Hall.



Education Initiatives

Through its education initiatives, MCC makes a lasting impact on youth choral arts and music education within its community and beyond. These initiatives include: professional development workshops, a new music commissioning project, a graduate conducting partnership with the Frost School of Music, and an undergraduate Teaching Apprentice Program.

To date the organization has commissioned 52 choral works for youth voices!
